RE: Overview of ABAG's Projections 2007

At the January Equity Analysis Subcommittee meeting, MCAC members were given some background on the modeling process used to create the equity analysis methodology for the regional transportation plan.

MTC staff commented that the data from the Association of Bay Area Government's (ABAG) Projections 2007 would be used in preparing travel forecasts for the Transportation 2035 Equity Analysis. Several MCAC members had questions about Projections 2007 and how the data is collected. Subcommittee members asked if county and city decisionmakers are intimately involved in the production of ABAG's Projections. In addition, subcommittee members wanted more information on what larger developments might not be included and what the actual cut-off data is for local policy survey data that was used in ABAG's Projections 2007.

At this coming Tuesday's subcommittee meeting, Paul Fassinger from ABAG will be on hand to give some background on how data is collected for ABAG's Projections, and answer any questions you might have.

Attached is a memo sent from ABAG earlier this year outlining proposed recommendations on Projections 2009 for the Joint Policy Committee's review. This memo also contains some background information on the process, which you may find helpful.
