Transportation 2035 Joint Advisor Workshops

As a reminder, the next Joint Advisor Workshop will be held on June 5 here at MTC after your EDAC meeting. This workshop will allow advisors to comment on the draft investment plan that MTC staff will be presenting the Planning Committee in June. We hope that you all can attend.

T2035 Public Outreach Presentation

A summary of the Phase II T2035 public outreach conducted during the months of May and June will be presented to the Planning Committee on June 13. The T2035 public outreach included: 1) a random telephone poll with 3,600 responses; 2) nine public workshops, one in each Bay Area county; 3) nine focus groups, one in each Bay Area county, recruited via the telephone poll; 4) ten community-based focus groups, recruited by organizations from low-income communities. MTC staff will present a summary of similarities and differences between the groups, along with key messages heard. We hope you can attend the meeting.

Railvolution Presentation Update

Per Commissioner Giacomini's request, we were able to submit the transit oriented development presentation to the Railvolution organizers for consideration. Using the title of "Accessibility of

Transit Oriented Developments: Bay Area Case Study,” the session will focus on the current state of the Bay Area’s accessible townhomes near transit, similar to the information presented to MTC’s Planning Committee in October 2007.
