Transportation 2035 Update

Planning Committee to Review Investment Alternatives

Several of you attended the last Joint Advisor Workshop on June 26, where Therese McMillan provided an in-depth look at the financially constrained investment package recommended by MTC staff. Workshop attendees were able to convey their funding preferences via electronic voting, and the results of the voting are currently being tabulated. Each of the three advisory committees will be discussing their funding preferences at their respective July meetings, and those preferences will be communicated to the Commission at its July 11th Planning Committee meeting. The Planning Committee will be approving the financially constrained investment program of projects and HOT network implementation objectives at that time. You are encouraged to attend the July 11th Planning Committee meeting if you are able.

T2035 Community-Based Focus Groups
