RESOLUTION NO. 3873

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is the regional transportation planning agency for the San Francisco Bay Area pursuant to Government Code Sections 66500 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, MTC is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the nine-county San Francisco Bay Area region (the region); and

WHEREAS, MTC, the State Office of Emergency Services (OES), the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), and public transportation operators within the region developed the Trans Response Plan (TRP) which was endorsed by the Bay Area Partnership in 1997; and

WHEREAS, the concepts and protocols described in the TRP are consistent with the California Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) Regulations (Title 19 Code of Federal Regulations Chapter 2400) and the National Incident Management System (NIMS) (Homeland Security Policy Directive No. 5); and

WHEREAS, MTC has developed the RTEMP, based on the framework of the TRP, in collaboration with State OES, California Highway Patrol, Caltrans, and the major public transportation agencies within the region to provide guidance for ongoing regional all-hazards planning and coordination to respond to disasters and to restore basic regional mobility in the Bay Area; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that MTC adopts the Regional Transportation Emergency Management Plan, attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein as though set forth at length; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the MTC Operations Committee is authorized to amend Attachment A as deemed appropriate and consistent with the applicable federal and state requirements; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Executive Director shall forward a copy of this resolution to the state agencies and public transportation providers, and to such other agencies and local officials as may be appropriate.
