RE: Report from Transportation Economics & Pricing Subcommittee

At your January 13 meeting, the chair of the Transportation Economics and Pricing Subcommittee will report on the subcommittee's discussion of the following questions and seek input from Advisory Council members:

- How should the TLC process study access issues, focusing on subsidized parking structures vs. alternative land use and access policies?
- Where might money be found in the new climate change a program to develop better economic and pricing policies?
- How should MTC advocate to State Agencies, such as CARB, HCD, and CSU, concerns and analysis of parking garages compared to rapid shuttles, to follow up on Doug Kimsey's letter to CARB?
- How is MTC working with the regional Joint Policy Committee to develop policy relating to parking structures vs. alternatives, and what more could be done?
- How should MTC work with local government to assist analyzing parking structures vs. alternative access? Should MTC help Hayward persuade CSUEB Hayward to use fast, frequent, and free shuttle access? Should MTC help Hayward study alternative uses of Proposition 1C funds for rapid shuttle, leased parking, shared parking, and an alternative structure at the South Hayward BART station?
