Transit Sustainability Project Select Committee Member Biographies

Mr. Tom Bates

Tom Bates has represented the cities of Alameda County on the Commission since February 2007. Commissioner Bates served two decades as a California legislator and four years as an Alameda County supervisor. In December 2002, he was elected Mayor of Berkeley, and was re-elected in 2006 and 2008. Currently, he is a member of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District Board, the Bay Conservation and Development Commission, the Regional Airport Planning Committee, the Joint Policy Committee, and is the immediate past-president of the Alameda County Mayor's Conference.

Mr. Dave Cortese

Dave Cortese has represented the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) on the Commission since February 2007. He is a member of ABAG's Executive Board and chair of the Regional Planning Committee. In 2008, he was elected to the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, representing District 3, and currently serves as the Board's vice president. Previously, Mr. Cortese served two terms on San Jose's City Council, where he was vice mayor for two years. He is vice chair of the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors' Finance, Government and Operations Committee, and chair of the Children, Seniors and Families Committee. He is also a member of the Disaster Council, where he serves as vice chair, the Joint Policy Committee, and the Valley Transportation Authority Policy Advisory Committee.

Mr. Bill Dodd

Bill Dodd has represented the cities and county of Napa on the Commission since February 2001. He served as Chair of the Commission from 2007 to 2009. In 2000, he was elected to the Napa County Board of Supervisors, representing District 4, and was re-elected in 2004 and 2008. He has served as chair of the Napa County Transportation Planning Agency, Napa County League of Governments, the Napa Flood Control and Water Conservation District, the Napa County Watershed Improvement Authority, and the Local Agency Formation Commission. He also represents Napa County on various boards and commissions, including the Joint Policy Committee, the Association of Bay Area Governments, the California State Association of Counties, and the Great Wine Capitals Global Network.

Mr. Federal D. Glover

Federal D. Glover was appointed to the Commission in December 2006 representing Contra Costa County. He began his third term on the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors in 2008, representing District 5, and served as president of the board in 2004 and 2008. In 1996, he was elected to the Pittsburg City Council, and served as mayor from 1998 to 1999. Federal has numerous committee assignments that oversee regional transportation, financial, land use, and relational affairs, in addition to active memberships on boards of local non profits, civil rights and statewide organizations.

Mr. Scott Haggerty

Scott Haggerty currently serves as Chair of the Commission, representing Alameda County since December 2000. He is a member of the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, and is currently serving his fourth term, representing District 1. Commissioner Haggerty serves on numerous boards and commissions, including the Alameda County Transportation Authority, the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority — where he serves as vice chair, the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, and the Board of Supervisor’s Transportation & Planning Committee.

Mr. Steve Kinsey

Steve Kinsey, representing Marin County and cities, has served on the Commission since January 1998. He served as Chair of the Commission from 2003 to 2005. He is a supervisor for Marin County, representing District 4, and is currently the second vice president. He is also chair of the Transportation Authority of Marin and the Countywide Planning Agency, and serves on the boards of numerous Marin County government agencies, including the Transit District, the Capital Improvements Financing Authority, and the Redevelopment Agency.

Ms. Amy Rein-Worth

Amy Rein-Worth has served on the Commission since February 2007, representing the cities of Contra Costa County. She is a member of Orinda’s city council. She was first elected in 1998, and was re-elected in 2002 and 2006. She was mayor of Orinda in 2000 and 2005. She has served as co-chair of the Contra Costa Transportation Authority, the Measure J transportation campaign, and the Orinda School Facilities bond campaign. She was also chair of the Contra Costa County Mayors Conference, and president of the League of California Cities East Bay Division.

Mr. Jon Rubin

Jon Rubin is the San Francisco Mayor’s appointee to the Commission. He was appointed in February 1995, and served as Chair from 2005 to 2007. He was vice president of the public relations consulting firm, Bay Relations, Inc., and in 2004, he became President/CEO of The Peninsula Coalition. In 1988, he served as chief of staff to state Senator Quentin Kopp. He has also served on the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board for Caltrain, the Bay Bridge Design Task Force, the Transbay Terminal Design Panel, the Transbay Crossing Study Committee, and the Joint Policy Committee, where he served as chairman in 2006.

Mr. James P. Spering

James P. Spering is the Commission’s longest serving Commissioner, having been appointed in February 1987. He served as Chair of the Commission from 1997-1999. Mr. Spering was elected to the Solano County Board of Supervisors in 2006, representing District 3. He served as mayor of Suisun City from 1986 to 2006. Commissioner Spering was instrumental in the formation of the Solano Transportation Authority, as well as the popular Amtrak Capitol Corridor intercity rail service linking

Sacramento and the Bay Area. Currently, he is a member of the Local Agency Formation Commission and the Solano Water Authority.

Ms. Adrienne J. Tissier

Adrienne J. Tissier has represented San Mateo County on the Commission since January 2006. She is currently serving as the Commission's Vice Chair. Currently, she is in her second term as a member of the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors. She also serves on the San Mateo County Transit District's (SamTrans) board of directors, and on the boards of the Health Plan of San Mateo and the San Mateo Medical Center. Before her election to the Board of Supervisors, Adrienne was a businesswoman for over 20 years and served two terms (1997-2004) as a councilmember in Daly City, including twice as mayor (1999 and 2003). In 1998, California lawmakers honored her as the Legislature's Woman of the Year for the 19th Assembly District.

Mr. Ken Yeager

Ken Yeager has represented Santa Clara County on the Commission since January 2007. He was elected in 2006 to the Santa Clara Board of Supervisors, representing District 4, and he is currently the president. From 2000 to 2006, he served on the San Jose City Council. Prior to that, he served two terms as a Trustee of the San Jose Evergreen Community College District. In December 2008, he was appointed by Governor Schwarzenegger to the board of the California Air Resources Board (ARB). He also serves on numerous boards and committees, including the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, the Association of Bay Area Governments, the Joint Policy Committee, Caltrain and the Valley Transportation Authority.
