Rebecca Long of MTC staff added that the preferred approach among stakeholders is a mandatory electronic vehicle registration along with increased penalties for failing to put license plates on a new vehicle in a timely manner. With respect to raising the necessary funds to maintain the region's freeways, Commissioner Lempert suggested including tolling on freeways in future legislative programs.
