 Subject: Plan Bay Area Draft Preferred Scenario Equity Analysis Results

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Over the past several months, MTC and ABAG staffs have worked on developing the Preferred Scenario and Investment Strategy for Plan Bay Area with input from this group as well as numerous other committees and stakeholders.

Following on the Equity Analysis of the Alternative Scenarios last December, another round of Equity Analysis results will be released with other Draft Preferred Scenario information scheduled to be presented to the Joint MTC Planning/ABAG Administration Committee May 11. To prepare for advance discussion of the measures at your May 9 meeting, staff will forward the relevant materials to this group once they are posted to the OneBayArea website.

Note the Preferred Scenario results will incorporate updated methodologies for two of the measures:

- The Housing and Transportation Affordability measure has been revised to reflect input given at the December 9 Joint MTC Planning/ABAG Administration Committee meeting and to incorporate a new employment-based income and housing cost forecast.
- The VMT Density measure was updated to incorporate a single land-use buffer around major roadways (as discussed with this committee at your March meeting) and also to address technical issues of double-counting of VMT within buffers that were overlapping in dense areas.

Further details will be available in a technical report staff is preparing on the Preferred Scenario Equity Analysis results which will be posted in advance of the May 11 Joint Committee meeting.
