RE: Funding Agreement – Implement Ramp Metering on US 101 in San Mateo County: San Mateo County Transportation Authority (SMCTA) (\$350,000)

This memorandum requests Committee approval of a Funding Agreement with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000, to implement ramp metering on US Highway 101 between 3rd Avenue and the San Mateo/San Francisco County line.

Background

Both the *Transportation 2035 Plan* and *Plan Bay Area* include funding for system management elements as part of the Freeway Performance Initiative (FPI). Under the FPI, ramp metering infrastructure has been installed and made operational on Interstate 280, and on US 101 south of State Route 92 in San Mateo County. Caltrans expects installation of ramp metering equipment on US 101 north of State Route 92 will be complete by the Summer of 2013, and ramp meters could be operational by Fall, 2013. The proposed funding agreement would support the development of a ramp metering implementation plan for US 101 north of State Route 92, completing the ramp metering system on US 101 through San Mateo County.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Committee authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and enter into a funding agreement with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (SMCTA) in an amount not to exceed \$350,000 to implement ramp metering on US Highway 101 from 3rd Avenue in San Mateo County to the San Mateo/San Francisco County Line.
