Toll Bridge Rehabilitation Program Update, BATA Resolution No. 104, Revised

Mr. Peter Lee, BATA staff presented and requested the Committee forward to the Authority for approval the Toll Bridge Rehabilitation Program Update, BATA Resolution No. 104, Revised. The update makes minor changes to project descriptions and budgets based on scope revisions and a recent bid opening. BATA staff plans on returning to the Committee in December with an informational update to the Toll Bridge Rehabilitation Program.

Contract – San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge Toll Plaza Improvement Project: ProVen Management Inc. (\$5,174,560)

Mr. Stephen Baker, BATA staff, presented the information on the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge Toll Plaza Improvement Project procurement. The work includes the replacement of crash cushions, replacement of the pump station building, and recladding of the existing toll canopy.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Cortese and the second of Commissioner Glover the Committee unanimously approved authorizing the Executive Director or his designee to: award the contract to ProVen Management, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$5,174,560, pending staff's review for responsiveness and responsibility; should staff determine that ProVen Management, Inc. is not responsive or responsible, then to Taber Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$4,936, 222; should staff determine that Taber Construction, Inc. is not responsive or responsible, then to Alten Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$5,195,480; and to use contingency funds in an amount not to exceed \$776,184 for changes associated with the work.

Contract Amendment – San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge West Span Bicycle/Pedestrian, and Maintenance Pathway Project Initiation Document: TY Lin International (\$300,000)

Mr. Peter Lee, BATA staff, presented the information on the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge West Span Bicycle/Pedestrian and Maintenance Pathway Project Initiation Document Contract amendment.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Glover and the second of Commissioner Campos the Committee unanimously approved authorizing the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and enter into a contract amendment with TY Lin International in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to complete the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge West Span Bicycle / Pedestrian, and Maintenance Pathway Project Initiation Document.

Toll Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program (SRP) Program Progress Report

Mr. Peter Lee, BATA Staff, presented to the Committee, for their information, updates on the San Francisco Bay Bridge East Span Seismic Retrofit Project. Mr. Lee also reported that the San Mateo-Hayward Bridge will be closed for two weekends: October 19 and October 26.
