MTC Resolution No. 4035, Revised

Subject: Cycle 2 OneBayArea Grant Program - Project Selection Programming

Background: In May 2012, the Commission adopted the Cycle 2 OneBayArea Grant (OBAG) Program for four federal fiscal years (FYs 2012-13 through 2015-16). The program establishes commitments and policies for investing roughly \$800 million in federal funds.

The county congestion management agencies (CMAs) have initiated the project selection process for County OBAG funding which involves a competitive project solicitation, evaluation, and selection process administered by the CMAs. As projects are selected, MTC staff confirms funding eligibility and includes the projects in the OBAG program, processes TIP revisions to include the projects in the federal TIP, and provides periodic follow-up reports to the Commission. This month, funds for various projects are being added to the OBAG program, as included in Attachment B to MTC Resolution No. 4035:

Alameda County

- Additional funding for CMA planning activities (\$3.3 million)
- Safe Routes to School (\$2.0 million)

Contra Costa County

- Additional funding for CMA planning activities (\$1.2 million)

Marin County

- Additional funding for CMA planning activities (\$0.4 million)
- Central Marin Ferry Bike/Ped Connection (\$1.5 million)

Issues: None.

Recommendation: Refer Resolution No. 4035, Revised to the Commission for approval. Because Resolution No. 4035, Revised is proposed for revision under multiple agenda items, it is included once under agenda item 4a with all proposed revisions.
