RE: Contract Amendment - I-880 Integrated Corridor Management: URS Corporation Americas (\$876,342)

This memorandum requests Committee approval of a contract amendment with URS Corporation Americas (URS) in an amount not to exceed \$876,342 to provide design services including assistance with Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for an initial project supporting the development of an enhanced incident management strategy for the I-880 corridor.


Background

In March 2011, MTC, in partnership with the corridor's stakeholders, including Caltrans, the Alameda County Transportation Commission and the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority, embarked upon an I-880 Integrated Corridor Management (ICM) Project. The goal of the I-880 ICM Project is to relieve congestion and improve mobility, accessibility and safety by identifying how existing and planned Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) and operations can be better coordinated and integrated across networks and jurisdictional boundaries. As part of this project, a coordinated freeway and arterial incident management strategy was identified for rapid deployment within the northern segment of the I-880 corridor.

In January 2011 the BATA Oversight Committee authorized contracts with fifteen consulting firms to provide on-call construction management and design services for BATA, MTC and MTC SAFE projects. URS was selected from this approved list of consultants to assist MTC SAFE with project management for the design of an I-880 ICM arterial incident management strategy. The cost of this amendment is consistent with funds budgeted in the current SAFE budget.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Committee authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and enter into a contract amendment with URS for the preparation of Plans, Specifications and Estimates in an amount not to exceed \$876,342.
