**Resolution Nos. 4100, Revised and 4101, Revised**

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**Subject:** Allocation of \$5.0 million in FY2013-14 Transportation Development Act (TDA) and State Transit Assistance (STA) operating funds to AC Transit to support transit operations.

**Background:** AC Transit has requested additional allocations of TDA and STA operating funds for FY2013-14. The Fund Estimate (MTC Res. 4086) has been revised since AC Transit submitted its initial request for funding for the fiscal year resulting in more funds available for allocation. These additional allocations would fully commit AC Transit's estimated TDA and STA funds.

TDA funds are derived from a ¼ cent sales tax collected statewide and STA funds are derived from a statewide sales tax on diesel fuel.

## ABSTRACT

### Resolution No. 4100, Revised

This resolution approves the allocation of fiscal year 2013-14 Transportation Development Act Article 4, Article 4.5 and Article 8 funds to claimants in the MTC region.

This resolution allocates funds to AC Transit, County Connection (CCCTA), LAVTA, NCTPA, Sonoma County Transit, Tri Delta Transit (ECCTA), Vacaville and WestCAT.

This resolution was revised on July 24, 2013 to allocate funds to Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District (GGBHTD), San Mateo County Transit (SamTrans), and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA).

This resolution was revised on July 31, 2013 to allocate funds to Vacaville and rescind funds from Sonoma County Transit.

This resolution was revised on September 25, 2013 to allocate funds to Fairfield, SolTrans, Union City Transit, and Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA).

This resolution was revised by Delegated Authority on October 23, 2013 to rescind and allocate funds to CCCTA.

This resolution was revised on November 20, 2013 to allocate funds to AC Transit.


RESOLVED, that MTC approves the findings set forth in Attachment B to this resolution; and, be it further

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code § 66500 et seq., the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (“MTC”) is the regional transportation planning agency for the San Francisco Bay Area ; and

WHEREAS, the Mills-Alquist-Deddeh Act (“Transportation Development Act” or “TDA”), Public Utilities Code Section 99200 et seq., provides that the State Controller shall, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99310, allocate funds in the Public Transportation Account (“PTA”) to the MTC region to be subsequently allocated by MTC to eligible claimants in the region; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 99313.6, MTC has created a State Transit Assistance (“STA”) fund which resides with the Alameda County Auditor for the deposit of PTA funds allocated to the MTC region; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Sections 99314.5(a) and 99314.5(b), claimants eligible for Transportation Development Act Article 4 and Article 8 funds are eligible claimants for State Transit Assistance funds; and

WHEREAS, eligible claimants have submitted applications to MTC for the allocation of fiscal year 2013-14 STA funds; and

WHEREAS, Attachment A to this resolution, attached hereto and incorporated herein as though set forth at length, lists the amounts of and purposes for the fiscal year 2013-14 allocations requested by claimants, and is from time-to-time revised; and


