| Program Evaluation Request for Proposals (RFP) (\$70,000)  | The RFP seeks a qualified consultant to conduct an evaluation of the Prosperity Plan Project, as outlined in the work plan. The project is anticipated to start in January 2014 and end in March 2015.  | Friday, August 9       |
| Regional Early Warning System for Gentrification (REWS) Call for Proposals for Coordinator Position (\$60,000) | The Housing Working Group is seeking a part-time staff position to coordinate the REWS project with University of California Berkeley (UCB), which is being funded by the California Air Resources Board, and up to six community-based organizations that will ground-truth the data and test the tool. The Coordinator will be hired from January 2014 to March 2015.                                     | Tuesday, September 3   |
| REWS Call for Proposals for Community-Based Organizations (\$60,000)   | The Housing Working Group is seeking three to four community-based organizations in specific case study sites (still to be determined) to work with UCB on the REWS project. The CBOs will be funded for work between January and December 2014.  | Tuesday, September 3   |
| Economic Prosperity Initiative Call for Projects (CFP) (\$1,100,000)   | The Economic Prosperity Working Group is seeking qualified and competitive proposals for pilot projects that promote upward mobility and access to economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income workers in the region. Categories of eligible projects will be informed by the Regional Prosperity Strategy. The pilot projects are anticipated to be implemented between April 2014 and March 2015. | Monday, September 30   |

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| <p>Housing the Workforce Initiative CFP (\$230,000)</p> | <p>The Housing Working Group is seeking qualified and competitive proposals for sub-grants that promote production and preservation of affordable housing near transit and neighborhood stabilization in areas at risk of displacement. | <p>Equity Initiative CFP (\$350,000)</p>                | <p>The Equity Collaborative is seeking qualified and competitive proposals for sub-grants that promote equity principles in local and regional processes.
