The Sonoma Valley Springs Area, which includes the unincorporated communities of Boyes Hot Springs, Fetters Hot Springs, El Verano, and Aqua Caliente is a designated Rural Investment Area placetype. This ethnically diverse community is in need of increased affordable housing opportunities, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and access to transit. A Springs Area Plan will be developed with a broad objective to revitalize the area into a pedestrian and transit oriented mixed use corridor. Specific goals include realigning land uses to create greater mixed use and higher intensity residential development around new transportation opportunities, facilitating an increase in bicycle/pedestrian paths and other alternative transportation options, and evaluating automobile parking needs for residential and commercial uses, in the context of transit oriented development. The primary focus of the Plan will be to maximize transportation connections to the proposed SMART station via bus, bicycle, and pedestrian modes. These connections will be oriented to the existing and future businesses within a half mile radius from the SMART station targeting the areas employees providing alternatives to single occupancy vehicles. Other components of the Plan will include increasing amenities and services, creating open spaces that encourage physical activity, establishing urban design standards to enhance the visual experience along Airport Boulevard, and creating a regulatory framework that encourages a diversity of industrial and commercial uses. A programmatic Environmental Impact Report will be prepared to analyze potential environmental impacts of the Plan and to streamline future development consistent with the Plan.
