RE: Committee Recommendations

The Legislation Committee met on July 11, 2014 and referred three items to the Commission:

• **Alameda County Transportation Sales Tax Increase**

This ballot proposal would augment and extend Alameda County's existing half-cent transportation sales tax by a half cent (for a total of 1 percent) from 2014 through 2045, providing nearly \$8 billion in new transportation funding for Alameda County.

**Committee Recommendation: Support Alameda County's Transportation Sales Tax Measure**

• **Transportation 2030: San Francisco November 2014 Bond Measure**

This measure seeks approval for a \$500 million General Obligation bond dedicated to transportation, focused on improvements to local street and roads, with an emphasis on pedestrian safety, and public transit improvements.

**Committee Recommendation: Support Transportation 2030: San Francisco's November 2014 Bond Measure**

• **AB 1864 (Daly) – Temporary License Plate Bill Study**

This bill requires the Department of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the California Highway Patrol, to conduct an assessment of the need to adopt a new temporary vehicle identification system that is different from the status quo. The Committee believes the need has been well established and the study would be a waste of time.

**Committee Recommendation: Oppose AB 1864 (Daly) unless amended.**
