**Subject:** No More TEAM grants that require regular DOL certification

Due to the pending permanent shutdown of TEAM on February 27, FTA will no longer accept grants or grant amendments for programs that require regular Department of Labor Certifications. We will continue to move forward any already submitted grants with hopes of award prior to February 27.

The following programs require DOL certifications and will no longer be accepted in TEAM:
