RE: Contract Amendment – On-Call Construction Management Services: San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge East Span Replacement Project: Hatch Mott MacDonald (\$495,000)

This item would authorize a contract amendment with Hatch Mott MacDonald (HMM) for on-call construction management services for the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge (SFOBB) East Span Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed \$495,000.

Background

In January 2014, after a competitive procurement, this Committee authorized the Executive Director to enter into contracts with a pool of eight firms, including HMM, to provide on-call construction management services.

Contract Amendment Request

HMM was part of the joint venture consultant team that provided program oversight support over the Toll Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program to BATA that expired last year. Due to its extensive experience and prior knowledge of the technical issues on the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge (SFOBB) East Span Project, staff selected HMM to continue to provide project support after the original joint venture expired. In July 2014, this Committee authorized a contract amendment to allow for continued program oversight and technical support for the SFOBB East Span Project. To support on-going work, staff is now requesting an amendment, in an amount not to exceed \$495,000, for continued construction management and technical support for the project.

Given the on-going questions raised on the bridge by the media and other parties, staff is proposing to maintain HMM support on the east span project through FY 2015-16, but to gradually reduce its level of support as the program winds down. HMM would continue to provide limited project oversight duties, including scheduling support, reporting, and administrative support. Attachment A includes a summary of HMM and its project team including small and disadvantaged business status.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that this Committee authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and enter into a contract amendment with HMM to provide continuing project oversight and technical support for the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge East Span Replacement Project through FY 2015-16 in an amount not to exceed \$495,000.
