The project is consistent with all six goals of the ATP program as the improvement in access will promote walking and biking for the large school community in a disadvantaged area. Pacifica Avenue is at the center of a conglomerate of three school campuses, with a combined enrollment of 1,800 students. Rio Vista Elementary School, Riverview Middle School, and the public library are located next to each other on the south side of Pacifica Avenue, and Shore Acres Elementary School is located on the north side. Traffic congestion is a major concern during drop-off/pick-up times, as there is a significant risk for students who walk or bike to school. Due to the lack of adequate pedestrian and bicycle facilities some students walk among slow moving traffic to cross the road where the sidewalk ends. If sidewalk was continuous, more students would feel encouraged to walk or bike to school, thus reducing traffic congestion. The proposed project will close the final gap of sidewalk at one of the most critical segments of Pacifica Avenue in front of Rio Vista Elementary School. This project will complete a continuous one mile stretch of sidewalk on the north side of Pacifica Avenue, from Driftwood Drive to Port Chicago Highway.
